

Scholarship requirements:

- Completed admissions application to the KU School of Engineering by January 1st (apply online at www.admissions.ku.edu)
- Student must be admissible to the KU School of Engineering
26 math ACT (620 math SAT)
3.0 high school GPA
- Student must successfully complete the Olathe Northwest A/E program
- Applicants must submit:
 1. **KU – Olathe Northwest A/E scholarship application**
 2. **Resume** detailing your extracurricular activities, leadership roles/awards/honors, volunteer/community service projects and hours, and work experience
 3. **250 – 500 word essay** explaining how the A/E program assisted in your growth and helped you to plan for your future – give specific examples.

This scholarship is renewable for four (4) years provided that the following criteria are met:

- 3.25 GPA or higher
- Must continue enrollment in the School of Engineering in an engineering curriculum
- Must continue to make progress (30 credit hours per year) toward an engineering degree and follow the department's curriculum guidelines
